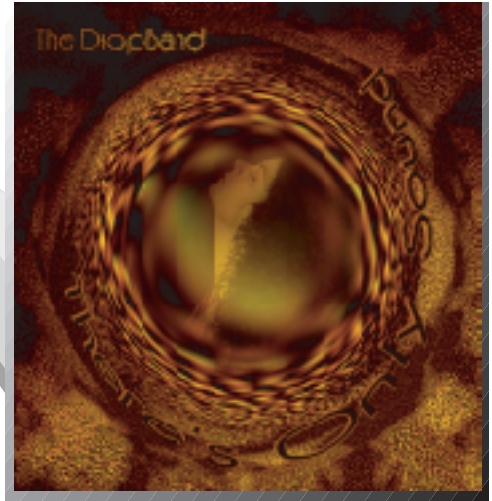

- The Drop Band's fourth album, 'There's Only Sound', is an eclectic mix of quirky psychedelic music adding **Christine Mascott's** lead vocals to the band's usually male dominated vocal sound. Always looking to try something new, The Drop Band explores many musical styles from straight ahead metal to blues to acoustic rock, from the humorous and back again.

Produced by Drop Band founder and guitarist **Paul Mascott (UnHappy Jack, Broms)**, There's Only Sound also features drummer **John Macaluso (ARK, TNT, Yngwie Malmsteen)**, **Derek Wieland (Kered)** on bass, **Hank Wagner (OZ, Denis Leary)** on harmonica and vocals, **Lane Sparber** on 12-string guitar, and the Drop Band horn section including **Dan Yeager** on Trumpet, **Sergio Bustamante** on Saxophone and **Nelson Foltz** on Trombone.

The Drop Band, founded in 1997 as the house band for Paul and Hank's theatrical show 'Drop' began making records with in 1999. Their recordings have achieved critical acclaim and their music has been licensed by movies and television including the MTV shows 'Road Rules', 'Extreme', 'Senseless Acts of Video' and 'Road Rules', in the independent film 'Flophouse' produced by Pyramid Productions and is also featured on **Radio Free Virgin**. They continue to develop new music on Syberdelix Records in New York City.
